A Large, Decentralized Organization

Interior is a large, decentralized agency with over 67,000 employees and 236,000 volunteers located at approximately 2,400 operating locations across the United States, Puerto Rico, U.S. territories, and freely associated states. We discharge our responsibilities on a \$15.8 billion total annual budget. DOI raises more than \$12.9 billion in revenues collected from energy, mineral, grazing, timber, recreation, land sales, etc

 - “Tell me what we have, where it is at, who is using it, and that it is *meeting the mission.*”



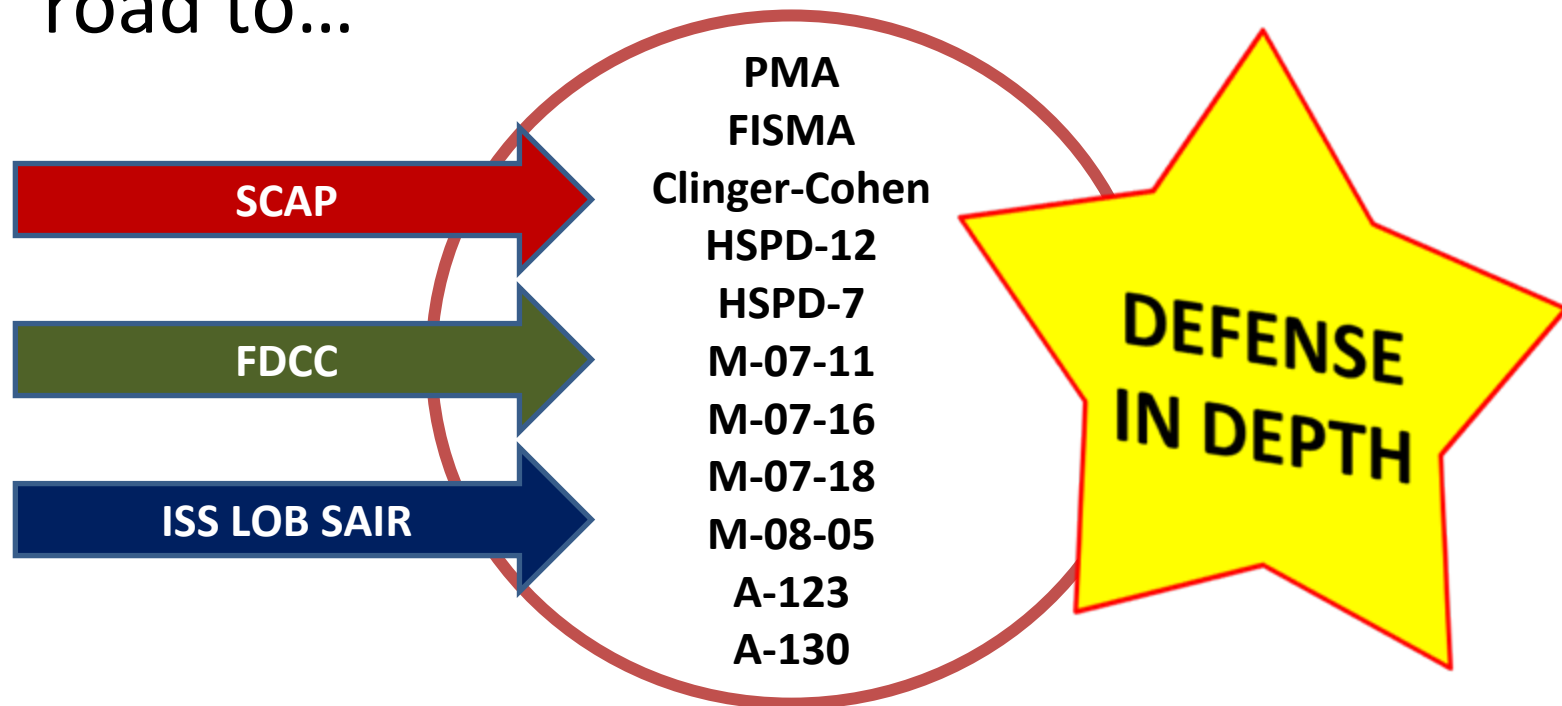
And Tomorrow:

What is ISS LOB SAIR?

- ISS LOB SAIR is Critically Important
 - Through GSA SmartBuy, DHS is creating a BPA that will make sure:
 - Our internal agency requirements are validated within a consensus environment.
 - Vendor products meet the mark!
 - Agencies will have access to enhanced tools that implement, validate, test, and maintain FDCC and SCAP configurations/implementations



S-CAP & FDCC Expectations for Vendors

- We expect that vendors will sell S-CAP and FDCC compatible & compliant:
 - Hardware
 - Printers, Copiers, Multifunction devices
 - General Purpose Computers
 - Software
 - Operating Systems
 - Major Applications
 - Custom Software
